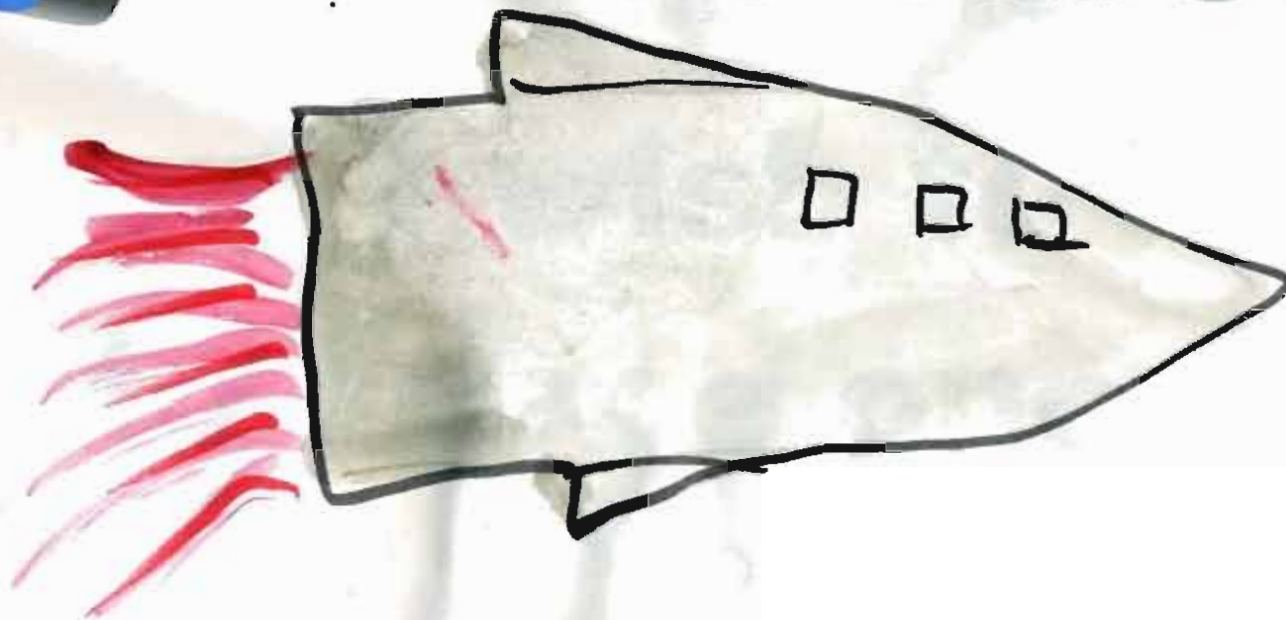


I Have a Dream

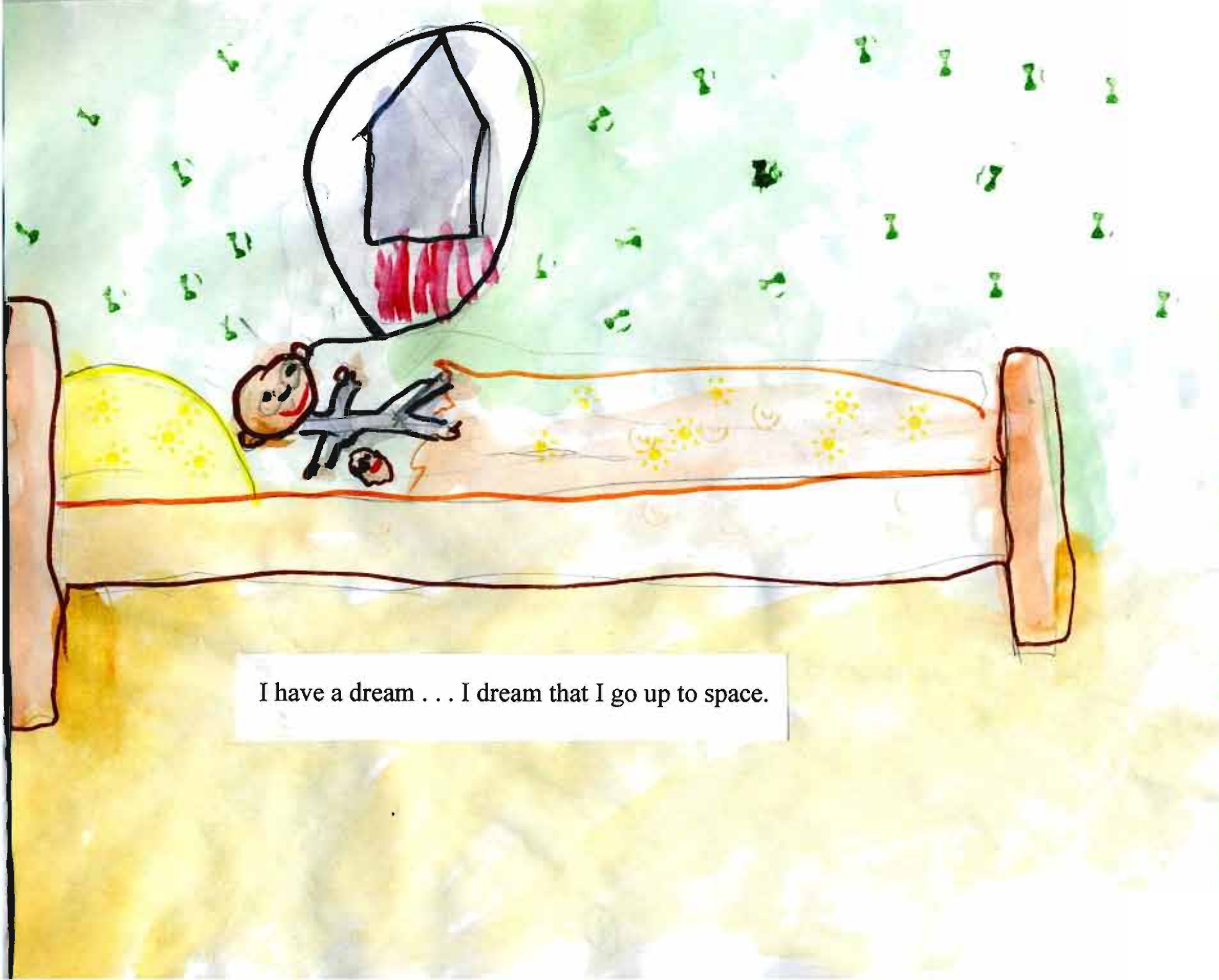

I have a dream . . . I dream that I go up to space.



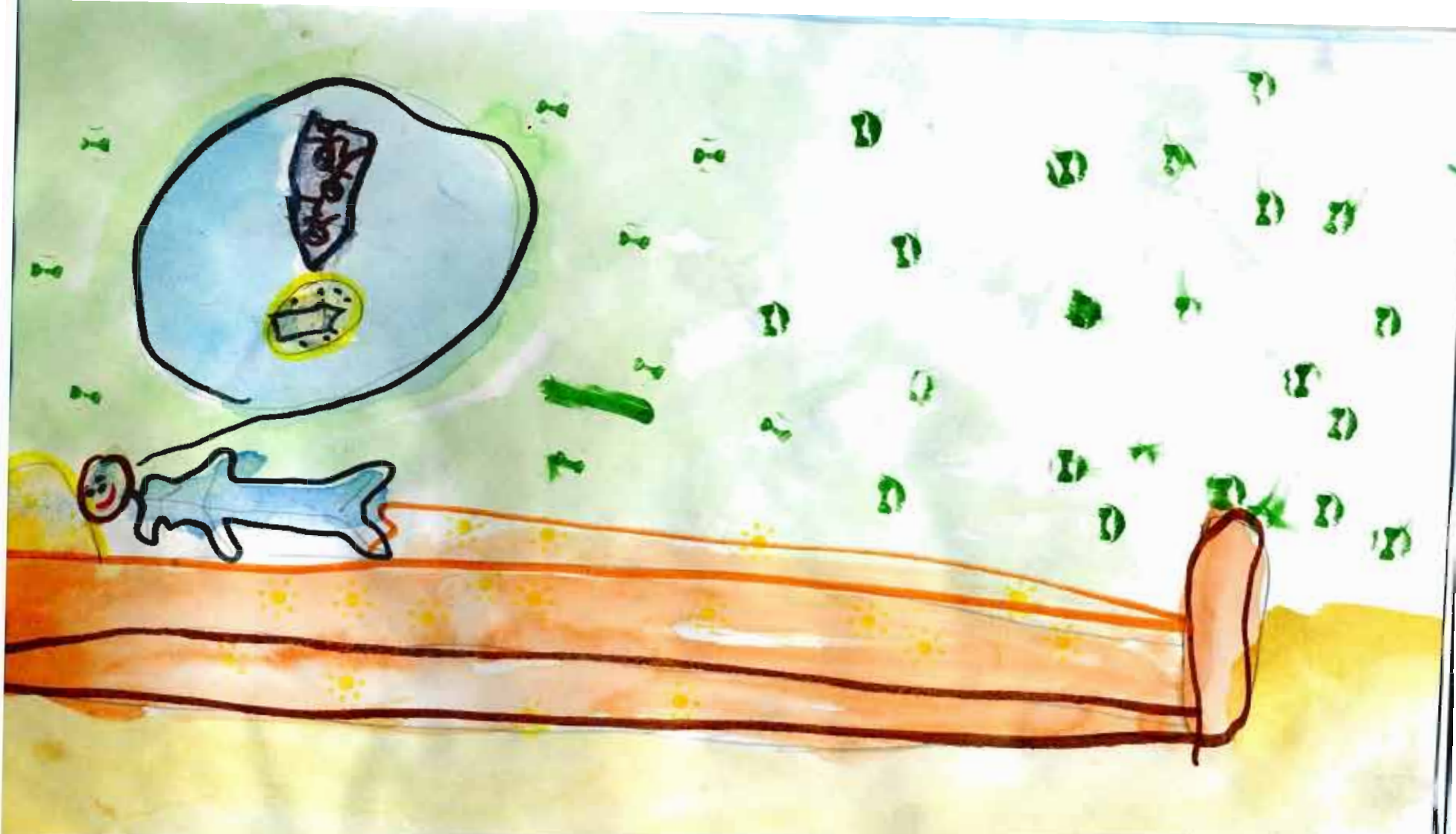
I will wear a spacesuit and I will bring air, some food and toys in a spaceship.
